## **RESOLUTION NO. 03172020**

WHEREAS, there is a pandemic outbreak of Coronavirus virus (COVID-19); and on 3/13/2020 President Trump declared an ongoing emergency because of COVID-19 and on 3/12/2020 Governor Bullock declared a state of emergency in Montana related to COVID-19 and with at least 6 presumptive COVID-19 cases in Montana;

WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of all the residents in the town of Medicine Lake is of prime importance

WHEREAS, the Town has committed all available resources to mitigating the impact of COVID-19 on Medicine Lake Mt. residents, and taken all possible action to combat and to alleviate the situation and local resources will not be adequate to cope with the situation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and the City Council that an emergency is hereby declared pursuant to Section 10-3-402, MCA, because expenditures for responding to an outbreak will be beyond the financial capability of the Town of Medicine Lake, Montana.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of this resolution be filed with the County Clerk and Recorder, County Assessor and the Montana Disaster and Emergency Services Division in Helena.
